The Research






The four subjects are divided into two levels:-




Level 1 is targeted at 4-6 years old or students who have completed a phonics programme.

Level 2 is targeted at 6-8 years old or students who are becoming confident in reading English.

The book covers are colour coded by subject and by level.








Level 1 reading books have 16 pages


b) Refer the "Easy Guide*" to select the correct Reading Books, Activity Book and Lesson Plan.


When teaching, read the story out loud, or play the MP3 file. Follow the Shapeys® Lesson Plan instructions.
